

Arizona LIHEAP facts:

CAMPAIGN FOR
HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Number Served: In 2009 Arizona has provided 46,383 households with LIHEAP financial assistance (there are 814,174 eligible households in the state).

Eligibility: AZ families receiving LIHEAP assistance have incomes below **200 percent of the federal** poverty level. As you can see in the chart, the majority fall well below the cap.

Arizona Funding:

The Fiscal Year 2009 Appropriations bill includes \$5.1 billion for LIHEAP, which will provide Arizona with **\$34.2 million** in funding.

As the chart displays, an increase in LIHEAP funding will enable Arizona to distribute assistance to a greater number of eligible households.
